

Behavioral Expectations

G2M programs are designed to ensure students receive the emotional, intellectual, and physical support that is essential for child development and well-being. The Wausau School District and community partner staff provide fun, educational, and challenging activities and seek to maintain an atmosphere conducive to learning. It is our responsibility that each child is in a safe, constructive environment. In order to support this environment, the following rules are to be followed by all G2M participants:

THE RULES:

- All students will be kind and respect self, others, and property.
- All students will behave in a way that positively contributes to the classroom or school site.
- All students will be on time and prepared for G2M activities.
- All students are not allowed to bring toys or expensive equipment. We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items. Students are asked to leave those items at home.

DISCIPLINE PLAN:

- **FIRST VIOLATION:** Child will receive a verbal warning.
- **SECOND VIOLATION:** Child's parents will be contacted and child may be suspended for a specific time period or removed from classes for the duration of that session.
- Please note that if your child requires services of a special education aide during the school day this program may not be appropriate without those individual supports in place. Parents may want to create a plan with their child for behavioral reinforcement and follow-through at home.

GROUND FOR IMMEDIATE REMOVAL:

- In the event of misuse of facilities, illegal or sexual activities, possession of drugs or firearms, fighting, threatening physical harm or using threatening language, bullying or harassing others, harming a teacher or student, destroying school or personal property, G2M staff has the right to immediately remove the student from the program. The parents/guardians of the students will be contacted, as will local authorities, if necessary. Decisions will be made based on all the information on hand and will be final.

Health Needs: Staff in G2M programs will be trained in First Aid, CPR and how to administer rescue medication. G2M staff are not trained or authorized to administer scheduled medication. Any prescribed medication will need to be administered prior to 3:30 PM. G2M is often staffed by community agencies, AmeriCorps members, college and/or high school students. Please let staff know of any allergies and dietary restrictions.

General guidelines:

- A nutritious snack and juice are served to all students in G2M after school classes.
- Permission slip is required for participation.
- **ATTENDANCE is important – please call, e-mail or text (715-573-1539) if your child will not be in class.**
- **STUDENTS WHO WILL NOT BE STAYING FOR AFTER SCHOOL MUST BRING A NOTE FROM PARENT, HAVE PARENT CALL SCHOOL OR TEXT ENRICHMENT COORDINATOR AT ABOVE NUMBER. IF A STUDENT COMES AND TELLS ENRICHMENT COORDINATOR THEY WON'T BE STAYING AND WE HAVE NO DOCUMENTATION (ABOVE), THE STUDENT WILL HAVE TO STAY UNTIL A PARENT IS CONTACTED.**
- Students may not always be placed in their first choice class as we have many students wanting to take classes. If there are more students in a class than the class limit, a lottery drawing will be done for that particular class. Students will be enrolled in one (1) class. If there is room in other classes, students may be offered another class.
- All students will be dismissed at **Door #1 (THIS IS THE MAIN DOORS BY THE OFFICE)**. Please NOTE there is NO BUSSING AVAILABLE at 4:45 PM for students. A parent/friend needs to pick up their child(ren) at 4:45 PM. Students will not be allowed outside when dark unless they see their parent/car.
